1. Failing to prioritize

- 2. Pray for wisdom (James 1:5)

- 4. Have faith that God's Word is what I must have—a necessity
- 5. Don't lose heart (Hebrews 12:1-3)
- 6. Faithfully pursue, and God will reward you
